# Italy, Art and Design June 17 to June 27, 2017, 3 Credits (Summer 2017)

## The Country:

Heart of the Roman Empire, birthplace of the Renaissance, and home of the Vatican and Roman Catholic Church, Italy has made innumerable contributions to Western Civilization. Though its history and landmarks are familiar to us from books and movies, there is no substitute for the first time you stand in front of the Colosseum where countless others have gone before you for over two millennia.

# The Program:

In this study abroad program you will experience many of the highlights of this fascinating country while focusing on art and design. Travel begins in Rome, and continues through Florence and ends in Venice. You will be immersed in Italian culture, art and design for 10 days with guided lectures, tours and support.

#### The Course:

INT 311 - Global Perspectives in Interior Design, 3 Credits

This course is a combination of hands-on learning, lecture and travel and is designed for liberal arts, art and interior design students. It combines collaborative effort and hands-on teamwork to focus on national and global design issues, and human factors through exposure to contemporary issues, historical architecture and design, varying dynamics, other cultures, and different economic groups. Lectures with information about destinations are presented prior to international departure. While abroad, you will participate in design charrettes (quick design challenges) and carry a sketch book to sketch what you are seeing and reflect using visual methods.
