The Course:

FLS-141 Elementary Spanish I, FLS-142 Elementary Spanish II, FLS-241 Intermediate Spanish I, FLS 242 Intermediate Spanish II or FLS-928 Independent Study

You will study at the Academia Latinoamericana de Español in Cuzco guided by Kirkwood faculty and local instructors for an immersive cultural and linguistic experience. You will be placed in one of five levels of Spanish based on your previous level of experience and Spanish placement scores.

The Country:

Peru is a dynamic country composed of many indigenous cultures. In addition to the more recent Spanish colonial culture, African and Asian influences help create the fusion that makes the country unique. The geography of Peru is equally fascinating, with desert, mountain, jungle and coastal climates. You will stay in the cosmopolitan Inca capital, Cuzco. The foremost city of the Inca Empire is now the undisputed archaeological capital of the Americas, as well as the continent's oldest continuously inhabited city. You will also visit the Incan city of Machu Picchu, probably the best known archaeological site on the continent.
