## **Fulbright Visitor from Nepal**

Kirkwood hosted Dr. Ajaya Bhattarai, Fulbright Scholar from Nepal for a visiting lecture on Thursday, February 21. His visit was funded by the Fulbright Outreach Lecturing Fund that encourage Fulbright scholars to travel to other schools, particularly community colleges to share knowledge about their culture and area of study.

Dr. Bhattarai, presented the following topic: "Nepalese Culture: The Culture of Nepal from the Perspective of a Fulbright Awardee". He spoke about the diverse regions of Nepal, it's unique geography sandwiched between the large countries of China and India, and it's welcoming people. He showed images of the Himalayas, Mt Everest, native dress, the

flag and shared videos about other Americans' experiences in Nepal.

The lecture was delivered to a full house of Kirkwood faculty, staff and students. Dr. Bhattarai also had the opportunity to visit the Glassblowing Lab located in the Art Annex area at Kirkwood where he was amazed at the beautiful work being done. Dr. Bhattarai said his visit to Kirkwood was overwhelmingly positive and he looks forward to spreading the word about what a great college Kirkwood is.
