Eagles Abroad: May was a busy month for Kirkwood Study Abroad! 44 students participated in one of four study abroad programs this past month. Here are some of the highlights:

Australia, Global Business: 19 students traveled with faculty leaders

Mark Abel And Erin Brokel to Sydney and Melbourne to complete



a global marketing project. Prior to departure the students worked virtually with their Australian peers to design a marketing plan for a local company in Melbourne. The project culminated with a group presentation to industry in Melbourne. In addition to the project, the group enjoyed cultural activities such as hiking the Blue Mountains, The Great Ocean Road, shopping at Victorian Market, and exploring Sydney Harbour.

Australia, Global Education Network



(GEN): 11 Kirkwood students traveled with faculty leader Jody Weigel to complete academic and cultural experiences in Melbourne. The students took classes and teamed up with their peers from Australia, Canada and Singapore on this GEN program. 4 students completed academic and field experiences in Human Services, 3 students focused on Animal Sciences and 4 Kirkwood students completed a Project Management experience with the Great Ocean Road Running Festival. Cultural opportunities included an Australian Rules Football (AFL) game, Phillips Island and the Great Ocean Road.

Denmark, Entrepreneurship and Creativity: Faculty leader Todd

Saville and Jon Weih went abroad with 5



students to Roskilde and Copenhagen. The group teamed up with their Danish peers from Zeeland Institute of Business and Technology (ZIBAT) to complete a project working with a local company. When they were not in the classroom, the group explored castles, Tivoli Garden, biked through downtown Copenhagen and took a ride on a Viking ship.

Greece, Service and Culture: Faculty leaders Serena Tarr and Brooke

Strahn-Koller led a group of 9 Kirkwood stu-



dents on an impactful service-learning program. The Kirkwood group partnered with Cross Cultural Solutions at the Ritsona Refugee Camp. The camp is home to refugees from Syria and other locations. The Kirkwood group stayed busy cleaning the female friendly space at the camp, planting a garden and working in the clothing distribution center. When they were not at the camp, they visited sites in Athens, Evia Islands and explored the oceanfront town of Chalkida.
